



Do you have a disabled child?

Would you like to go out in the evening in the knowledge that all their needs will be met in your absence?

A Specialist Sitter will be able to help!

Specialist Sitters are qualified, experienced Ofsted registered childminders who, as part of Northamptonshire's Childminding Network, offer an evening service on weekdays and weekends. This service is managed by Northamptonshire Childminding Association (NCA) and will be available from 1st May 2011

How much will it cost?

You will need to pay the childminder £5.00 an hour for the time you use, including any handover time. NCA will pay the remaining fee with funds from the Aiming High initiative.

How will it work?

When you register with NCA you will be asked to complete a profile about your child. When you need to use the service, contact NCA with dates and times and they will put you in touch with a suitable childminder who can help, it's as easy as that!

How can I be confident that my child will be well looked after?

Specialist Sitters are Network Childminders, which means they are Quality Assured. They are monitored and supported by their local NCA Development Worker. They all hold a current 1st Aid certificate and a Level 3 qualification in childcare: they also access lots of relevant training/workshops as part of their network membership.

What do I need to do?
